Eligibility for group numbers

Skaters must be enrolled in group classes for the **Winter & Spring** sessions in order to participate in the class level group number. Any of the following apply:

- Snowplow Sam through Basic Skills
- Pre-Free Skate - Free Skate 5/6.
- Hockey Class (in a number designed just for hockey)
- High School class or Theater On Ice class

The level of your skater's **Winter** session class (**as of Jan 5, 2026** is the class level you should register for the ice show, unless told otherwise by the Skating Supervisor.

Eligibility for featured performance opportunities

- Free Skate 3 & 4 enrolled in class, may sign up as a line leader. (Must attend the SPS rehearsals)
- Free Skate 5 & 6 enrolled in class, qualify for one of three step-out spots in a group number (*brief routine performed leading into and out of a group number*) for all 3 performances- first in registration will have priority, **or** a two-night duet.

Eligibility for a solo performance

Skaters above FS 6 qualify for a solo if they meet the required criteria:

ONE NIGHT SOLO

Be enrolled in a class the Winter and Spring sessions
Have a landed axel
Have a Staff Coach, be an active staff member or Be a Wilmette resident

THREE NIGHT SOLO

Be enrolled in a class the Winter and Spring sessions
Have a landed axel and one landed double,
Have a Staff Coach, be an active staff member or Be a Wilmette resident

Skaters NOT ENROLLED IN WINTER and SPRING CLASSES may receive a Three-night solo, if they meet the following requirements:

- *Have a landed axel and two landed doubles, or have passed the USFS Intermediate FS test*
- *Skate 3 hours (Six sessions) a week on Wilmette freestyle sessions*
- *Have a Staff Coach, be an active staff member or Be a Wilmette resident*

Graduating High School Seniors will be guaranteed a solo spot

Soloist will be required to participate in at least one group number in addition to their solo

Rehearsals

Class time is **not** used for rehearsals (exception being Theater On Ice and High School classes). Rehearsals will overlap with the classes for 4 weeks (5 wks for **Senior Precision and Adv FS**)

A rehearsal schedule is included in this packet. Refer to it for the scheduled rehearsal times for your skater.

All participants must attend a minimum of 3 out of 4 group rehearsals.

Please notify the office or your choreographer immediately, should you have a conflict of any kind.

FS 1 - FS 4 will participate in their class level group number *and* the Opening number.

FS 5 – Adv FS will participate in their group level number, Opening number, and Senior Precision (optional)

Dress Rehearsal and Shows are MANDATORY for all cast members. Promptness is crucial for a smooth run-through. Please allow enough time to put on costumes and skates. At the dress rehearsal the finale will be rehearsed first so skaters may stay and watch or leave following their group's number.

Video

Video of the show will be made available to every registered skater in the show. At least two of the three shows will be videotaped.

Costumes

Costumes for the group numbers will be ordered by the Wilmette Park District. Fill in the measurements for the skater on the back page of this packet before turning in your packet.

Costumes are made to fit standard sizes; minimal alterations may be needed to compliment your skater. Once ordered, **no refunds or exchanges can be made.**

Please allow room in your measurements for 4 months of growth for your child.

An accurate girth measurement is crucial.

Costume Day (optional) - Saturday, January 17 and Jan 24 from 10:00am - 12:00pm. We will have staff available to assist you with measuring for the costumes and registering for the ice show.

Registration / costume measurements and payment due on or before- **Monday, January 26, 2025.**

Any form received after that date will be subject to availability and a \$30 late fee, with no exceptions.

Your costume order will not be processed until the form is complete and the fee is paid.

Featured Skaters and Soloist will provide their own costume for their individual featured number.

The registration fee includes your costume for the group number, choreography, rehearsal ice-time and a video link of the show. Freestyle 1 and above will also receive a show T-shirt.

All Female skaters shall wear skating Suntan tights. Danskin, Mondor or Capezio Suntan tights can be purchased at Allegro Dance Boutique in Evanston, Rainbo Sports in Glenview, or online. Tights will be available for purchase at the office for \$12 a pair. No shiny tights.

Rental Skates

There is no charge for rental skates during the performances or rehearsals. Rental skates may be taken home for the dress rehearsal and shows as long as they have been signed out by leaving your credit card number and contact info at the front desk.

Skaters are responsible for covering rental skates with white boot covers for girls and black for boys, during the dress rehearsal and show performances (Available at Rainbo Sports in Glenview, or online.)

Skaters in the hockey number do not need to cover their skates.

It is always our objective to run a fun, safe show, and **we need your help** to accomplish this! We would greatly appreciate it if a female member of your household (Mom, Grandparent, adult Sibling, Guardian or Nanny) would consider volunteering for at least 1 show or the dress rehearsal.

Volunteers are needed to assist the staff in watching over skaters, helping with costumes, hair bows, laces, make-up, calming nerves, etc.

Dress rehearsal volunteers will assist in guiding the skaters to designated seating areas to watch the dress rehearsal

We would like to have **at least 2 volunteers per group** for each **performance**. You may volunteer to assist your skater's group for more than one performance, if you'd like.

Volunteers are allowed to leave the dressing room area in order to watch their group skate and must return following the number. It is required that you remain in the dressing room until all of your skaters are accounted for at the end of a performance. Many Ice Rink staff members are on hand to offer support and guidance throughout the show.
